PROJECTS ON THE POINT

From SDOT

In continuing efforts to improve safety and accessibility, the stairs at SW Andover Street between 21st and 20th SW are being rehabilitated.

Several City-owned stairways were built in the mid-1900s, with some of them built as early as the 1920s. SDOT's Roadway Structures division conducts periodic inspections to inventory the condition of each stairway and identify a list of repairs that are needed. The stairway at SW Andover Street



between 21st Ave SW and 20th Ave SW has been prioritized for safety improvements; repairs started in January 2016. These repairs will ensure the stairs meet current safety standards and are a step forward in improving pedestrian connections and accessibility in your community.
